**CODE OF ETHICS**

1. WE RESPECT THE DIGNITY AND INTEGRITY OF STUDENTS ON CAMPUS.

- a. We commit to treating students with love and respect.
- b. We agree to be straightforward with students.

2. WE RESPECT THE DIGNITY AND INTEGRITY OF OTHER CAMPUS MINISTERS.

- a. We commit to treating other campus ministers with love and respect.
- b. We agree to be cooperative, not competitive members of the CMA.

3. WE RESPECT THE UNIQUENESS OF THE PROGRAMS OF OTHER CAMPUS MINISTRIES AND FAITH TRADITIONS AND THE STUDENTS INVOLVED THERE.

- a. As our convictions allow, we shall encourage cooperation among our students in an effort to create a unified spirit of campus ministry and fellowship.
- b. We recognize that our primary field of prospective members are those with no faith tradition or without a campus ministry affiliation or commitment.

4. WE RESPECT THE PROGRAM AND POLICIES OF MISSOURI S&T.

- a. We shall have due regard for administrative policies on all levels.
- b. We see ourselves as cooperative members of the university community, and shall act as part of it.
- c. If we find it necessary to exercise our freedom to criticize or protest, we shall attempt to do so with a dignity worthy of our offices as religious leaders. Our sincere effort will be to seek a peaceful and equitable solution to any conflict with the university system.
